Numerous examples of archaic sculpture in bronze and marble, some of hammered-out work, are to be seen in all the museums, a large proportion of which are bas-reliefs representing the figure in profile. Good examples are Figs. 70, 71, which show a general resemblance to the Assyrian sculptures rather than Egyptian, as well as those found at Selinus (Fig. 68). But the examples in the archaic room, at the British Museum, must be studied in order to come to any clear understanding of the...
