This eminent soldier and jurist was born in Charlestown, Mass., April 4, 1820. He served with distinction during the war of the Rebellion, rising in rank from Major of the Third Battalion of Rifles, M.V.M., in April, 1861, to Brevet Major-General in April, 1865. He was twice chosen Commander-in-Chief of the Grand Army, viz., in 1873 and in 1874. Since his administration the office of commander-in-chief has been filled by three other comrades of the Department of Massachusetts, all of whom have passed on to the eternal camping ground; and to them, George S. Merrill, John G. B. Adams and Wilmon W. Blackmar, this volume is dedicated. Under the appropriate caption will be found tributes to their memory, that to Comrade Merrill written by Comrade...
